ABOUT THE STUDY

- This multi-site research study will find the genes that are important in the development of Tourette syndrome
- Locating genes will give us an understanding of the biology of TS and make individualized treatments possible.
- This research is funded by the NIH through the Tourette Syndrome Association and involves six participating university centers.

HOW CAN I HELP?

Participating in the TS Genetics study will involve:

- A visit to The Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore OR
- A home visit by a team member
- Self-report questionnaires reviewed by a physician
- A blood draw
- A 15-minute computer activity

You will be compensated \$25 for your participation and all visit expenses will be covered.



WHO IS ELEGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

- Children and adults diagnosed with Tourette Syndrome
 - Participants must be 7 years or older
