The Topic:

Tourette syndrome: The need for comprehensive & systemic outpatient counseling facilities to treat lifelong comorbidities as well as tics relating to the condition.



This study is being performed utilizing an in-depth interviewing approach to research. Interested participants will meet with the researcher in person or via Skype to perform an in-depth interview for a 2-hour session. In depth interviews consist of 15 questions geared toward talking about what it is like to live life with comorbid TS, and the need for counselors who are trained in treating comorbid conditions of TS as well as tics. This study is being performed to assist with development of centers that provide counseling for people with comorbid TS, as research is revealing that treatment needs are different for people with comorbidities relating to TS, and treating comorbidities in counseling centers without appropriate training can lead to ineffective treatment, treatment drop-out, and/or poor quality of life for individuals diagnosed with comorbid TS. 2. Have you received your diagnosis from one of the following? (Neurologist, Medical Doctor, Psychiatrist)
3. Are you over the age of 18 years of age?
