



## TS Camp Volunteer Description and Guidelines

<b>Location</b>	Black Rock Retreat Center, Quarryville, PA
<b>Position Title</b>	Youth Mentor, TS Camp
<b>Purpose</b>	To energize, interact with, offer acceptance and supervise the youth.
<b>Key Responsibilities</b>	Offer acceptance and supervise the youth during most daytime activities on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Youth mentors will be assigned to a small group of youth and will work with them throughout the weekend. Some groups will have 2 mentors assigned. Most activities are led by camp staff. The mentors are there to engage, supervise and care for the campers.
<b>Time Commitment</b>	Friday afternoon, June 8th through Sunday afternoon, June 10th. Sometimes a Youth Mentor is unable to commit for the entire weekend. PA-TSA can accommodate scheduling for Youth Mentors when informed ahead of time.
<b>Relationships</b>	Works with Camp Counselors, other Youth mentors, Black Rock camp staff and PA-TSA staff to ensure a safe and fun time for the Camp attendees.
<b>Reports to or Partners with</b>	Reports to PA-TSA staff
<b>Training &amp; Development Opportunities</b>	Internet training is done with all volunteers approximately 1-2 weeks prior to camp. All youth mentor volunteers are given a detailed schedule and responsibilities list upon their arrival at camp.
