



TS Camp Volunteer Description and Guidelines

Location	Black Rock Retreat Center, Quarryville, PA
Position Title/ Requirements	Junior Youth Mentor, TS Camp Open to teens ages 17-19 with a desire to gain experience and leadership skills mentoring our youth campers.
Purpose	To assist the Camp Counselors and youth mentors. To energize, interact with, offer acceptance and supervise the youth.
Key Responsibilities	Offer acceptance and supervise the youth during most daytime activities on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Jr. Youth mentors will be supervised by a lead Youth Mentor or Camp Counselor. Along with their supervisor, they will be assigned to a small group of youth and will work with them throughout the weekend. Most activities are led by camp staff. The Camp Counselors, Youth Mentors, and Jr. Youth Mentors are there to engage, supervise and care for the campers.
Time Commitment	Friday afternoon, June 8th through Sunday afternoon, June 10th.
Relationships	Works with Camp Counselors, Youth mentors, and other Jr. Youth mentors, Black Rock camp staff and PA-TSA staff to ensure a safe and fun time for the Camp attendees.
Reports to or Partners with	Reports directly to their assigned lead Mentor or Camp Counselor, as well as to PA-TSA staff
Training & Development Opportunities	Internet training is done with all volunteers approximately 1-2 weeks prior to camp. All youth mentor volunteers are given a detailed schedule and responsibilities list upon their arrival at camp.
